ORDER

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF), Office of the General Counsel, following a determination by its Public Information and Records Management Division, that pursuant to 3DCMR §3002.5 (March 2007), Mary M. Streett, ANC 1B05, failed to timely file, a Summary Financial Statement of Candidate for the Office of Member of an Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC Summary Financial Statement) for the 2010 General Election, on or before January 31, 2011, as required by 3DCMR §3002.5, and also failed to file on or before the OCF sanctioned extended filing deadline of April 1, 2011.

By Notices of Hearing, Statements of Violations and Orders of Appearance dated September 7, 2011 and September 19, 2011, OCF ordered Mary M. Streett (hereinafter respondent), to appear at scheduled hearings on September 16, 2011 and September 28, 2011, and show cause why she should not be found in violation of Title 3, District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, §3002.5, and fined accordingly.

Summary of Evidence

OCF alleges that the respondent failed to timely file the required ANC Summary Financial Statement for the 2010 General Election, on or before April 1, 2011.

On September 27, 2011, the respondent filed an affidavit in explanation of the alleged filing delinquency. Respondent stated that the late filing was due to an oversight occasioned by extensive, work-related travel commitments. Moreover, respondent stated that she neither raised nor spent funds in support of her ANC campaign. Respondent stated that she was not aware of OCF's earlier hearing until September 26, 2011. Respondent further stated that she contacted OCF on September 27, 2011 for instructions concerning how to proceed. On September 27, 2011, respondent filed the required ANC Summary Financial Statement with OCF.

Findings of Fact

1. Respondent ran as a candidate for ANC Commissioner of SMD 1B05 in the 2010 General Elections.
2. Respondent was required to file an ANC Summary Financial Statement with OCF on or before April 1, 2011.
3. Respondent filed the required ANC Summary Financial Statement with OCF on September 27, 2011.
4. Respondent has no record of a prior filing delinquency.
5. Respondent is currently in compliance with applicable regulation(s).

Conclusions of Law

Based upon the record provided by OCF, I therefore conclude:

1. Respondent violated 3DCMR §3002.5.
2. The penalty established at D.C. Official Code §1-1103.05(b)(3), and 3DCMR §3711.2(ee) for failure to timely file an ANC Summary Financial Statement, as required by 3DCMR §3002.5, is a fine of \$30.00 per day for each business day subsequent to the due date.
3. In accordance with D.C. Official Code §1-1103.05(b)(3), the respondent may be fined a maximum of \$2,000 for failing to timely file an ANC Summary Financial Statement.
4. For good cause shown pursuant to 3DCMR §3711.6, the Director of Campaign Finance (Director) may modify, rescind, dismiss or suspend any fine.
5. Respondent's explanation for failing to timely file, in that the filing delinquency was an oversight due to her extensive work-related travel commitments, and that she complied with the filing requirement at the earliest practicable time, constitute good cause for suspension of the fine.
