ORDER

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (“OCF”), Office of General Counsel (“OGC”), pursuant to an allegation(s) by OCF’s Public Information & Records Management (“PIRM”) division that **Pedro Rubio** (“Respondent”), Treasurer for PEDRO RUBIO CAMPAIGN failed to file the March 10th Report of Receipts and Expenditures on or before Monday, March 11, 2013; in accordance with the District of Columbia Official Code §1-1163.09(b) and Campaign Finance Act of 2011.

In accordance with the District of Columbia Official Code §1-1163.03 (a)(1) (H), by Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated April 5, 2013, OCF ordered respondent Pedro Rubio to appear at a scheduled hearing on April 17, 2013 and show cause why he should not be found in violation and fined accordingly. Respondent filed the required report on March 18, 2013 and is currently in compliance with the statute.

Recommendation

In view of the foregoing and information included in the record, I HEREBY RECOMMEND that the Director WITHDRAW the Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance, dated April 5, 2013 and SUSPEND any fine in the matter.
