ORDER

Statement of the Case

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (hereinafter OCF) Office of the General Counsel following a determination by its Public Information and Records Management Division, that pursuant to The Campaign Finance Act of 2011 (The Act), codified in DC Official Code 1-1163.01, Christian Carter, treasurer for the campaign committee "Carter at Large 2014" failed to timely file, a Receipt and Expenditure Report (hereafter R&E) for July 31, 2015, on or before the sanctioned extended date of August 17, 2015.

By Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated August 31, 2015 and September 18, 2015 respectively OCF ordered Christian Carter (hereinafter Respondent), to appear at a scheduled hearing on Wednesday September 16, 2015 and on Thursday October 1, 2015 respectively and show cause why he should not be found in violation of Title III of the Campaign Finance Act of 2011, and fined accordingly.

Summary of Evidence

OCF sent the Notices of Hearing dated September 16, 2015 to the Respondent via regular mail and sent the second Notice of Hearing dated September 18, 2015 via certified mail to the address of record for the Respondent. Notices of Hearing were also sent electronically to chrcarter@hotmail.com.

The Notices of Hearing sent via the regular US Postal Service were not returned to the OCF, and it is the presumption that they were delivered to the Respondent's address of record. The Notice of Hearing sent via certified mail was returned marked "Return to Sender", "Attempted-Not Known", "Unable to Forward." Moreover, an attempt was made by OCF to contact Respondent by telephone using the number listed on his registration form. That effort was fruitless. The telephone number was inoperative.

Respondent did not appear for either of the scheduled hearings. Respondent is found in violation of the District of Columbia campaign law by default judgment.

Findings of Fact

Having reviewed the allegations and the record herein, I find:

1. Respondent was the candidate and treasurer of record for the principal campaign committee "Carter at Large 2014."
2. Respondent committee was required to file a July 31, 2015 R&E Report on or before the sanctioned extended date of August 17, 2015 in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 1-1163.09
3. Respondent treasurer never filed the July 31, 2015 R&E Report. He also has not responded to the Notices of Hearings sent to him via the US Postal Service and electronic mail. It is the presumption of the OCF that the Notices of Hearing was delivered to Respondent via the regular and electronic mail.
4. Respondent candidate and committee are currently not in compliance with the statute.

Conclusions of Law

Based on the record provided by the OCF, I therefore conclude:

1. Respondent PCC violated DC Official Code §1-1163.09(b).
2. The penalty established at DC Official Code §1-1163.09, §1-1163.35, 3 DCMR §§3711.2(f), 3711.3 and 3711.4 for failure to timely file a July 31, 2015 R&E Report is a fine of \$50.00 per day for each business day subsequent to the due date.
3. In accordance with DC Official Code 1-1163.35, the respondent PCC may be fined a maximum of \$1,800.00 for failing to timely file a July 31, 2015 R&E Report. On the date of the second scheduled hearing the report was thirty six (36) days past due.
4. For good cause shown pursuant to 3 DCMR 3711.6, the Director of the Office of Campaign Finance (Director) may modify, rescind, dismiss or suspend any fine.

Recommendation

In view of the foregoing and information included in the record, I hereby recommend that the Director impose a fine in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00) in this matter.
