ORDER OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISMISSAL

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) upon inquiry conducted by OCF that, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02 (2001 Edition), **Mario Acosta-Velez** (hereinafter Respondent) failed to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement (FDS) for calendar year 2009 by May 17, 2010, and also failed to file by the OCF sanctioned extended filing deadline of June 18, 2010;

WHEREAS Respondent served in a position within District of Columbia Government that required compliance with the aforementioned D.C. Code statutory provisions;

WHEREAS pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02(b), OCF relied on the listing of potential filer information submitted by the Agency of Respondent's engagement, which information contained Respondent's name;

WHEREAS the address and contact information provided to OCF by the Agency for Respondent was inaccurate, and Respondent therefore did not receive information necessary to satisfy the filing obligation at issue;

WHEREAS a reasonable amount of time, energy, and effort has been expended to locate Respondent for purposes of enforcement of the filing obligation at issue, and further pursuit of the same would necessitate undue burden and cost upon the resources of OCF and District of Columbia Government;

NOW BE IT HEREBY ORDERED, that the charge of failure to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement for calendar year 2009 is hereby DISMISSED.
