ORDER OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISMISSAL

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) upon inquiry conducted by OCF that pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02 (2001 Edition), ALAN BARAK (hereinafter Respondent) failed to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement (FDS) for calendar year 2010 by May 15, 2011, as required by D.C. Official Code §1-1106.02, and also failed to file on or before the OCF sanctioned extended filing deadline of June 10, 2011.

WHEREAS Respondent served in a position within District of Columbia Government that required compliance with the aforementioned D.C. Code statutory provisions;

WHEREAS pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02(b), OCF relied on the listing of potential filer information submitted by the Agency of Respondent's engagement, which information contained Respondent's name;

WHEREAS by Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated August 1, 2011, OCF ordered Respondent to appear at a scheduled hearing on April 11, 2011;

WHEREAS Respondent provided a credible explanation for the untimely filing in that Respondent should be exempt from filing since he was not hired until December 6, 2010 and only work 25 days in the 2010 calendar year;

IT IS ORDERED that the Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated August 1, 2011 is hereby VACATED that the charge of failure to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement for calendar year 2010 is hereby DISMISSED.
