ORDER OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISMISSAL

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) upon inquiry conducted by OCF that pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02 (2001 Edition), CANDICE ASHLEY (hereinafter Respondent) failed to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement (FDS) for calendar year 2010 by May 15, 2011, as required by D.C. Official Code §1-1106.02, and also failed to file on or before the OCF sanctioned extended filing deadline of June 10, 2011.

WHEREAS Respondent served in a position within District of Columbia Government that required compliance with the aforementioned D.C. Code statutory provisions;

WHEREAS pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02(b), OCF relied on the listing of potential filer information submitted by the Agency of Respondent's engagement, which information contained Respondent's name;

WHEREAS Respondent failed to file a Financial Disclosure Statement on or before June 10, 2010;

WHEREAS by Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated August 1, 2011 and August 15, 2011, OCF ordered Respondent to appear at a scheduled hearing on April 11, 2011 and August 24, 2011;

WHEREAS Respondent filed the required Financial Disclosure Statement for calendar year 2010 on August 17, 2011 and submitted a statement explaining the untimely filing;

WHEREAS Respondent provided and credible explanation for the untimely filing in that Respondent became inundated with multiple personal issues, including health problems, work issues and family matters that all arose simultaneously causing her to inadvertently miss the required FDS filing deadline; however, upon notice of her delinquent status, Respondent took immediate action to correct her noncompliance by filing the required FDS online.

WHEREAS Respondent has been a timely FDS filer for the past two (2) years and is currently in compliance.

IT IS ORDERED that the Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated August 1, 2011 and August 15, 2011 is HEREBY VACATED that the charge of failure to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement for calendar year 2010 is HEREBY DISMISSED.
