**ORDER**

**Statement of Case**

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (“OCF”), Office of the General Counsel (“OGC”), pursuant to an allegation(s) by OCF’s Public Information & Records Management (“PIRM”) Division that Adrian Jordan, Treasurer for Ward 5 Democrats political action committee failed to file the October 10<sup>th</sup> Report of Receipts and Expenditures (“October 10<sup>th</sup> R&E report”), which was due on October 10, 2014 in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 1-1163.09(b) (2012) and 3 DCMR § 3017.2 (August 2013).

In accordance with D.C. Official Code §1-1163.03(a)(1)(H), by Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated October 23, 2014, the OCF ordered Adrian Jordan (“Respondent”) to appear at a scheduled hearing on November 17, 2014 and show cause why Ward 5 Democrats political action committee should not be found in violation and fined accordingly.

**Summary of Evidence**

On October 23, 2014, the OCF submitted a Notice of Hearing to Respondent via regular and electronic mail. That same day, the OCF received an email from Respondent regarding the Hearing Notice electronically submitted. Respondent explained that he recently appeared to the OCF for a hearing and filed a Notification of Non-Support stating that the political action committee would no longer support any candidate in the upcoming election during the 2014 calendar year. It was Respondent’s understanding that he was no longer obligated to file committee reports after completing the Notification of Non-Support.

Records at the OCF reflect that Respondent filed and PIRM approved a Notification of Non-Support for Ward 5 Democrats. Therefore, Respondent was not required to file the October 10<sup>th</sup> R&E report.

**Recommendation**

In view of the foregoing and information included in the record, **I HEREBY RECOMMEND** that the Director VACATE the Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance dated October 23, 2014.

Any party adversely affected by an Order of the Director may: (1) file a Motion for Reconsideration (Motion) with the OCF within five (5) days after receipt of an Order, provided that relevant evidence was omitted from consideration at the hearing (3 DCMR § 3709.13); or (2) obtain review of the Order by filing a request for a **hearing de novo** with the Board of Elections within fifteen (15) days from the date of issuance of an Order. Any fine imposed by the Director, pursuant to § 3711.2 shall become effective on the sixteenth (16<sup>th</sup>) day following the issuance of a decision or Order; provided that, the Respondent does not request a **hearing de novo** with the Board of Elections.
