ORDER OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISMISSAL

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) upon inquiry conducted by OCF that, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02 (2001 Edition), Betty Bass (hereinafter Respondent) failed to timely file by May 15, 2010, a Financial Disclosure Statement (FDS) for calendar year 2009.

WHEREAS Respondent served in a position within District of Columbia Government that required compliance with the aforementioned D.C. Code statutory provisions;

WHEREAS pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02(b), OCF relied on the listing of potential filer information submitted by the Agency of Respondent's engagement, which information contained Respondent's name;

WHEREAS OCF further relied on the information provided by the Agency of Respondent's engagement that Respondent's employment with District of Columbia Government officially terminated prior to January 31, 2009 and Respondent is no longer engaged by the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS no evidence has been presented to show that Respondent was notified during separation or within a reasonable time afterwards, by the Agency of Respondent's engagement that she was required to file a final FDS for calendar year 2009 after separation from her employment with the District of Columbia;

NOW BE IT HEREBY ORDERED, that the charge of failure to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement for calendar year 2009 is hereby DISMISSED.
