**ORDER OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISMISSAL**

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) upon inquiry conducted by OCF that, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02 (2001 Edition), **Wendi Brown** (hereinafter Respondent) failed to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement (FDS) for calendar year 2009 by May 17, 2010, and also failed to file by the OCF sanctioned extended filing deadline of June 18, 2010;

WHEREAS Respondent served in a position within District of Columbia Government that required compliance with the aforementioned D.C. Code statutory provisions;

WHEREAS pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-1106.02(b), OCF relied on the listing of potential filer information submitted by the Agency of Respondent's engagement, which information contained Respondent's name;

WHEREAS Respondent filed a Financial Disclosure Statement on March 26, 2011;

WHEREAS Respondent provided a credible explanation in that Respondent has been deployed overseas to Afghanistan since January 2010 and was not aware that she had a continuing duty to file after deployment; and upon being advised, Respondent took action to correct her noncompliance by filing;

WHEREAS Respondent has no history of filing delinquencies and is currently in compliance with the Statute;

NOW BE IT HEREBY ORDERED, that the charge of failure to timely file a Financial Disclosure Statement for calendar year 2009 is hereby DISMISSED.
