- (1) Utilizing ANC office for personal business and unjust enrichment, conflict of interest, and unlawful disbursement of ANC grant funds;
- (2) Enhancements to ANC 4A office that were not approved without community comment by Toliver to further enlarge his law practice and personal business ventures;
- (3) Complaint filed against ANC Commissioner Sara Green;
- (4) Complaint concerning ANC 4B check #4612, Fred Grant \$100.00 Printing & Copying 2011 budget;
- (5) Complaint concerning ANC 4B approval of payments for unauthorized meeting room rentals and food;

It is by Order of the Director this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2012;

**ORDERED**, that complainant's motion is denied on the basis that the original complaint relied on a news article, whose content was misapplied by complainant to form the predicate for a complaint which was otherwise unsupported by additional documentation or facts.
