This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) upon inquiry conducted by OCF that, pursuant to D.C. Official Code §1-1102.06(a) (2001 Edition), the respondent PAC failed to timely file a December 10, 2004 Report of Receipts and Expenditures (December 10, 2004 Report).

Upon review of the record herein, I find that respondent filed a Notice of Non-Support with OCF on July 5, 2004. Thus, the respondent PAC was not required to file a December 10, 2004 Report. Accordingly the respondent PAC did not violate the applicable provision of the statute. I further find that the respondent is currently in compliance with the statute.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance issued in this matter be hereby vacated.
