This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF) Office of the General Counsel pursuant to a referral from the Reports Analysis and Audit Division (RAAD) that, the Mike Brown for Shadow Senator Principal Campaign Committee (hereinafter respondent PCC) failed to timely respond to a Request for Additional Information in violation of D.C. Official Code §1-1103.02(a) (1) (A) (2001 Edition).

Upon review of the record herein, I find that the referral to the Office of the General Counsel was withdrawn by the Audit Manager pursuant to the respondent PCC's timely compliance with the requirements of the RAAD on the date of the referral. Thus, the respondent PCC did not violate the applicable provision of the statute. I further find that the respondent is currently in compliance with the statute.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Notice of Hearing, Statement of Violations and Order of Appearance issued in this matter be hereby vacated.
