Upon review of the record herein, I find that the respondent has satisfied the fine imposed in the Director's Order issued on June 8, 2015. Consequently, I further find that the respondent is in compliance with applicable regulations.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no further action be taken in this matter.

Any party adversely affected by any Order of the Director may: (1) file a Motion for Reconsideration (Motion) with OCF within five (5) days after receipt of an Order, provided that, relevant evidence was omitted from consideration at hearing (3DCMR §3709.13); or (2) obtain review of the Order by filing, a request for a **hearing de novo** with the Board of Elections, within (15) days from the date of issuance of an Order. Any fine imposed by the Director, pursuant to 3 DCMR §3711.2 shall become effective on the 16<sup>th</sup> day following the issuance of a decision and/or Order; provided that, the Respondent does not request a **hearing de novo**, pursuant to §3709.11.
