ORDER

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF), Office of the General Counsel, following a determination by its Public Information and Records Management Division (PIRM), that pursuant to 3DCMR §3002.6 (March 2015), Jennie Nevin, Candidate, ANC 1B02 failed to timely file, a Summary Financial Statement of Candidate for the Office of Member of an Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC Summary Financial Statement) for the 2014 General Election, on or before March 16, 2015, the OCF sanctioned extended filing deadline.

Upon review of the record herein, I find that the respondent withdrew as a candidate for ANC 1B02 as evidenced by the execution of the Board of Elections' Candidate Withdrawal Form on October 28, 2014. I further find that the respondent withdrew her candidacy prior to the November 4, 2014 General Election. The respondent filed the required ANC Summary Financial Statement, notwithstanding her belief that she was not required to file based on her withdrawal of candidacy. Consequently, I recommend that the hearing notice in this matter be vacated.



Any party adversely affected by any Order of the Director may: (1) file a Motion for Reconsideration (Motion) with OCF within five (5) days after receipt of an Order, provided that, relevant evidence was omitted from consideration at hearing (3DCMR §3709.13); or (2) obtain review of the Order by filing, a request for a **hearing de novo** with the Board of Elections, within (15) days from the date of issuance of an Order. Any fine imposed by the Director, pursuant to 3 DCMR §3711.2 shall become effective on the 16th day following the issuance of a decision and/or Order; provided that, the Respondent does not request a **hearing de novo**, pursuant to §3709.11. Fines imposed shall be paid within ten (10) days of the effective date of the issued Order of the Director. Make a payment by check or money order payable to the District of Columbia Treasurer.
