ORDER

This matter came before the Office of Campaign Finance (OCF), Office of the General Counsel, following a determination by its Public Information and Records Management Division (PIRM), that pursuant to 3DCMR §3002.6 (March 2015), Peta-Gay Lewis, Candidate, ANC 5D01 failed to timely file, a Summary Financial Statement of Candidate for the Office of Member of an Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC Summary Financial Statement) for the 2014 General Election, on or before March 16, 2015, the OCF sanctioned extended filing deadline.

Upon review of the record herein, I find that the respondent attempted to file the required report timely with the assistance of OCF staffers during the week of March 4, 2015. I further find that during the referenced period, the agency's Electronic Filing System (EFS) migrated to a new platform, thereby causing some interference with the normal processing of online financial reports during that timeframe. Consequently, based on OCF's receipt of the required ANC Summary Financial Statement, I recommend that the hearing notice in the matter be vacated.



Any party adversely affected by any Order of the Director may: (1) file a Motion for Reconsideration (Motion) with OCF within five (5) days after receipt of an Order, provided that, relevant evidence was omitted from consideration at hearing (3DCMR §3709.13); or (2) obtain review of the Order by filing, a request for a **hearing de novo** with the Board of Elections, within (15) days from the date of issuance of an Order. Any fine imposed by the Director, pursuant to 3 DCMR §3711.2 shall become effective on the 16th day following the issuance of a decision and/or Order; provided that, the Respondent does not request a **hearing de novo**, pursuant to §3709.11. Fines imposed shall be paid within ten (10) days of the effective date of the issued Order of the Director. Make a payment by check or money order payable to the District of Columbia Treasurer.
